


The delegate from HK Ms. Angela Kong asked why AEF has appointed a company from India, not from Qatar where the AEF Headquarter belongs.

Keeping in view the current situation we must adapt to the new technology and develop ourselves accordingly.

The delegate of Pakistan Dr. Farooq Ahmed thanking everyone said that the development of Equestrian Sports, especially Show Jumping has been improved in Pakistan and we would like to have the same level of support from AEF for further growth.

DISCIPLINE CHAIR REPORT:

Dressage

The Dressage Report was presented by the Chair. Dressage Mr. Waldo Yeh.

Highlights

- Summary on AEF U21 Dressage Championship (No of participating NFs, Riders, and the Finals).
- 3rd AEF U21 Dressage Championship new proposed format was discussed.
- World Challenge / AEF U21 Qualifier, standards were discussed.
- Hosting NFs eligibility of the U21 final and the NF of AEF President are eligible for 2 finalists.
- The 2nd and 3rd Final will be conducted at the same time.
- Ages of athletes and horses(Athletes aged no more than 21 years old) & Horses (Minimum 5 Years old)
- Qualifications: 2 Judges (at C and B/E; including one FEI foreign Judge and one local FEI judge/certified national judge). The president must be an FEI Foreign Judge (min. 2*) and will be appointed by AEF to judge in the assigned qualifiers.
- AEF Dressage promotion during Covid 19 by doing proposing Asia Cup National Dressage Open.
- AEF sponsorship with USD 1,000/- for each NF sponsored by AEF will be provided.

Chair Dressage Mr. Waldo Yeh said that yes they will be informing the decision of that topic to all involved participants.

DISCIPLINE CHAIR REPORT:

Eventing

The Eventing Report was presented by the Chair. Eventing Col. Sam Deva.

Highlights:

- As we all know about Covid -19 has attacked all activities throughout the world, which now affects all the events that create activities. Even the Tokyo Olympic games have to be postponed from 2020 to 2021.
- CCI Events in Asia also decrease, in terms of the number of events which is effective to develop Eventing discipline.
- However, on the top level of Eventing riders, Asia riders have achieved the biggest number ever in the Tokyo Olympic Games, that is China, Japan, and Thailand for teams. Hong Kong and India for Individuals.
- FEI Asia Eventing Championship, held in Pattaya, Thailand for the 3rd time in 2019.
- Eventing Officials Development, we do need a program to support our Asian Officials more, especially the position of technical delegates into the higher level to officiate important events in Asia, like the Asian Games.
- Asian Games 2022 in China, We as a committee, would like to propose the level of the eventing competition at 3L. The reason for this level are;
- Since 1998, the level of the Evening of Asian Games has never been raised higher.
- The Combination with the 3L level completion with MER will automatically be eligible to enter 4S in 2023, which is the qualifying year of Paris Olympic year 2024.
- There are arguments between quality and quantity. For us, We do believe the way to develop our beloved sport is to support the quality.

Endurance

The Endurance Report was presented by the Chair. Endurance Mr Essa Al Adhab.

Highlights:

The delegate from Pakistan NF commented that they have arranged 3 big endurance events in the past 3 years and in the coming time Pakistan wants to establish this sport but as we have an issue with horse transportation this becomes difficult to organize such events. so as we request to find a way to handle this situation.

Chair. Endurance Mr. Essa Al Adhab answering the comment said that this is a major problem and we are trying to target.

The delegate from Malaysia NF Mr. Umar asked about how many 4* level judges are currently present in your region.

Answering which Mr. Essa Al Adhab said that this is a big challenge for us and now we are communicating with FEI, and I believe we will solve this issue soon.

Tent Pegging

The Tent Pegging Report was presented by the Committee Member Mr. Ahmad Afsar.

Highlights:

- Five Nation Tent Pegging Tournament of AEF member countries at Salalah, Oman was held in August 2019, participating countries were (Oman, Pakistan, Qatar, India, Saudi Arabia). Asian Tent Pegging Championship in India was held in November 2019.
- AEF Tent Pegging Jury & Steward Courses at the above two Championships for the interested candidates from AEF member federations.
- Training of Riders of 3 non Tent Pegging playing nations of AEF
- 1st International Conference was held on Tent Pegging in Delhi, India
- 1st AEF U-21 Tent Pegging Championship (Tri-Nation)
- 1st AEF Women's Tri-Nation Tent Pegging Championship.
- After 2020 Tent Pegging Events, AEF TP Committee to plan AEF Asia Cup Qualifiers for an ASIA CUP held every two years/yearly.
- 1st AEF Tent Pegging Training Clinic (Host Country by AEF TP Committee) – Minimum 3 Training Clinics Yearly.
- Demo of TP at Asian Games or inclusion of TP at Asian Games.

Nepal currently is a provisional member of FEI, a committee of FEI has to visit Nepal to check the facilities in Nepal and after that, and they will confirm the membership. As AEF being “MOU” partners with FEI, AEF cannot accept anybody as a permanent member unless fully approved by FEI.

Considering the geographical location of both of the countries AEF decides to put Sri Lanka Nepal under the Regional Group 3.

ASIAN GAMES 2022, OCA – HAGOC PRESENTATION.AG VENUE DEVELOPMENT STATUS & EDFZ

DEVELOPMENT

This report was presented by the HAGOG Management Team.

Highlights:

- Our vision of making a green, smart ethical Asian Games, preparation has been almost completed for the most part with the support of AEF.
- The Covid - 19 has caused a lot of hardships and restrictions but we have organized special arrangements for the venue preparation.

- We have ensured that the work is well coordinated and have applied new methods to accomplish them at a greater pace.
- The first phase of the sports entry has been completed; good progress has been made for the opening and closing ceremony. IT broadcasting, event promotion, and logistics services.
- All the preparations are scheduled by the end of this year and the venue will be open for operation, we will be in close contact with AEF to follow up about the remaining arrangements.

A PPT was shared on-screen sharing brief information about Hangzhou and the adjacent areas, Event venues, overall status in venue & event organizing, competition schedules, EDFZ Control System, Quarantine policy, etc.

AG VENUE DEVELOPMENT & EDFZ STATUS (HAGOC, OIE & AEF UPDATE)

This report was presented by the AEF Secretariat & FEI Eventing Specialist Ms. Catrin Norinder:

After the presentation, the DSG added that the overall presentation was an update on the current status of the project. The AEF is constantly in touch with the HAGOC team, Officials and TDs are have been appointed to take part in the organizing process.

- TDs and Officials were not able to go to China as China has a very strict 21 Days quarantine rule upon arrival, so it is very difficult for everyone to visit. AEF has requested the HAGOC team to communicate to the provincial Govt. about the bubble-to-bubble movement for officials, unfortunately, that has been declined twice.
- Secondly, the contractors also requested us for the visits of our officials as they have time limits as per the contracts in which the TDs and the Course Designers for the cross-countries have to visit the venue. The arena for SJ and Dressage has already been prepared but for eventing, the cross country track is still under construction and unless the Course Designer visits the venue they cannot carry forward with the construction.
- These issues plus the veterinary protocol and temporary horse import into China, we have requested the OCA to kindly provide us the necessary information and also assist us to get permission from the Chinese Govt. for the bubble to bubble movement.
- Ms. Catrine Norinder (FEI) sharing her view said that she understands the cross country issue, it would be very good if bubble to bubble travel can be done because we are not able to find anyone who is comfortable enough to isolate themselves for quarantine for 21 days during the full season.
- It would be good if we can resume this conversation afterward, we have some ideas that we can discuss, we are waiting a little bit for what kind of competition formats are being proposed and also the level of the different competitions.

ASIAN GAMES 2022, LEVEL OF COMPETITIONS, OPEN DISCUSSION & DECISION.

AEF proposed the same level of competition as the Asian Games Jakarta 2018

Ms. Catrin Norinder (FEI) stated that we need to review this proposal, as well as the proposal that the AEF suggests not raising the bar, and that we need to discuss it with the technical committees before confirming anything. It will be difficult to decide on this short time frame for eventing, but we will give our review for SJ and Dressage soon.

TEMPORARY HORSE IMPORT & VETERINARY PROTOCOLS, AG 2022 – CHINA (OCA).

This issue has already been shared with OCA and HAGOC, that they communicating with the Chinese Govt. on this and will update soon.



FEI ASIAN CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019 REPORT (THA NF).

This report was presented by Mr. Gerald Kuh.

Thanking everyone the former Event Director of the 2019 Asian Championships said that it was a very successful event and was an important milestone in the development of equestrianism in the Asian region.

- 3 Major Olympic inaugural disciplines Jumping Dressage and Eventing with 13 Asian participating countries.
- It was the 1st Asian Championship following the European Championship.
- There was a total of 7 sets of medals distributed in different disciplines.
- 50 FEI officials, more than 100 staff & contractors members were involved to bring this dream come true.
- 1 million USD – Charter flight for all horses was supported by Mr. Harald Link, He also contributed the prize money & has invested in the Thai Polo & Equestrian Club.
- Interesting Facts and Figures were shared along with the experience of some participants.
- Broadcasting, TV Stories, Live Streams were done in major sports channels across the globe.
- Successful social media campaigning was done.
- A short video was presented refreshing the memories.

FEI ASIAN CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2023. OPEN DISCUSSION & FEI FEEDBACK

Thanking everyone for the chance to address this topic at the GA, Ms. Aine Power continued that as the DSG AEF mentioned the SG of FEI have sent the email at the end of January regarding this championship, The idea here will be following a formal bidding procedure unlike Asian Championship 2019. We know that there are already some NFs who have shared their interest organize the event but we would like to make sure that each NF gets a chance, hence the bidding process will be effective with proper deadline dates.

From FEI's point of view, we see the Asian Championship as a crucial championship and we wish it continues. We would like to keep everything clear from the beginning, the opportunity to bid should be given to every NF and the information about the number of participants, level of competition must be mentioned.

The main idea of today's discussion is to get an idea of the important topics like which disciplines should be included, what levels to be followed. The idea that whether or not there should be Olympic Qualifiers in this event is a bit premature at this moment as we have not decided the level of the competitions yet.

Apart from these topics, we have other things to consider like horse transportation and to ensure that NFs those who want to attend the Championships can actually attend.

Q & A

Thanking everyone, Mr. Harald Link stated that as Thailand has previously hosted the Asian Games, the country will once again desire to host such a prestigious event. We also thank the FEI and AEF for their assistance, and we also support the bidding process.

Ms. Nabila Ali from Kuwait asked that is there any proposed deadline for the bidding and if there are so many NF wants to host and will participate in the bidding process, what will be the criteria to choose the host.

Answering, Ms. Nabila Ali, Ms. Aine Power said that it is tricky to say what will be the deadline from now as we have not decided the bidding starting date but if we receive consolidated feedback from the NFs by end of August in the AEF group that will give us some time perhaps end of September we can potentially open a bid. Then we can give a period of 6 weeks to 2 months for the NFs to digest the information and then submit their page to FEI. Talking about the criteria in general, as the criteria are decided internally, we usually give more scope to the multi-discipline bid other individual disciplines but that depends on the range of bids we get, The bid

is usually sent to the Technical Committee to get evaluated and an agreement is made on which the bid winner gives their confirmation.

Mr. Harald Link proposed that we are thinking about putting three Olympic disciplines and Endurance and we are deciding between Asian Games and Olympic Game level according to what the participating members are interested in, will make it easy.

The DSG of AEF Mr. Abid SK Tarin said that we will very soon send an email to all NFs to expedite and share their details with the AEF.

Mr. Gerald Kuh added to the point that before starting the bidding process it is most important to choose the disciplines and set the Levels because it will take the MERs some time to do the panning, secondly any organizer who are planning to organize will take 2 years to plan properly so I think we should provide these information first to the FEI so that they can open the bid and the rest could be done. As Mr Harald Link mentioned, we also should mention Endurance and Para Dressage in the disciplines because if we see participants from Asia do really good at these two disciplines.

Now talking about the point of whether to keep Olympic Qualifier or not with this event, The Asian Games is always held one year before Olympics and World Championships in that way it becomes a perfect chance for the Asian athletes to qualify for these two big events.

Theoretically, there are very few countries who are jumping qualifying level we can consider kind of having a mixed team like Pan Americans so if some riders are there that those can ride big tour level, these riders can get some extra points, that's how the Pan American games are using mixed team format to get their team selected into Olympic Qualifiers.

Thanking Mr. Gerald Kuh for his valuable feedback Ms. Aine Power said that from the rules point of view, we must also keep in mind that we do not have much time to discuss Olympic qualifiers, whatever changes we will make them go to the GA to get approved. We are not ready with the disciplines and level of the game yet, from a rule logistics point of view it will prepare everything and get signed off, when we are talking about Olympic Qualifier be it in 2023 or down the line, it is always important that the participants from all over the world should be able to participate so then the horse transportation part is to be tackled.

The DSG Mr. Abid SK Tarin said that now we will be reverting back to all NFs to submit their feedback and to express their interest to host the Asian Games 2023 and send a request to FEI so that we can windup everything before the end of August so that AEF will be able to move further.

FEI ASIAN CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2023 BID PREPARATION.

He thanked everyone for the chance to able to present

- A description was given when Thailand was hit by AHS, FEI came forward to help us before its spread. - The mission of the Asian Games is to bring up Asian Talent and embracing local resources.
- The goal is to uplift the competition standard.
- The expected numbers in the NF participation are expected to increase in the upcoming 2023 and we also want to add Endurance and Para dressage to be added in the event category list.
